Scientists use the word "multiverse" to describe the idea that other universes may exist beyond our own. Several scientific theories postulate multiverses. What they all have in common is the possibility that our own observable space and time is not the only reality.

The most popular multiverse theory (a level I multiverse) is called inflationary cosmology. This is the idea that within a fraction of a second after the big bang the universe expanded exponentially at an extremely rapid rate. This theory explains a lot of the properties of our universe, such as how it is structured and how galaxies are distributed. This theory predicts that inflation could continue to occur indefinitely, which could create multiple universes, each in their own "bubble," and which may not have the same physical properties of our own.

Another interesting theory is known as the many-worlds interpretation of quantum mechanics (a level II multiverse). According to this theory, which describes the behavior of matter in mathematical terms, it is possible for timelines to branch into alternate realities where our choices play out differently and lead to very different outcomes.
