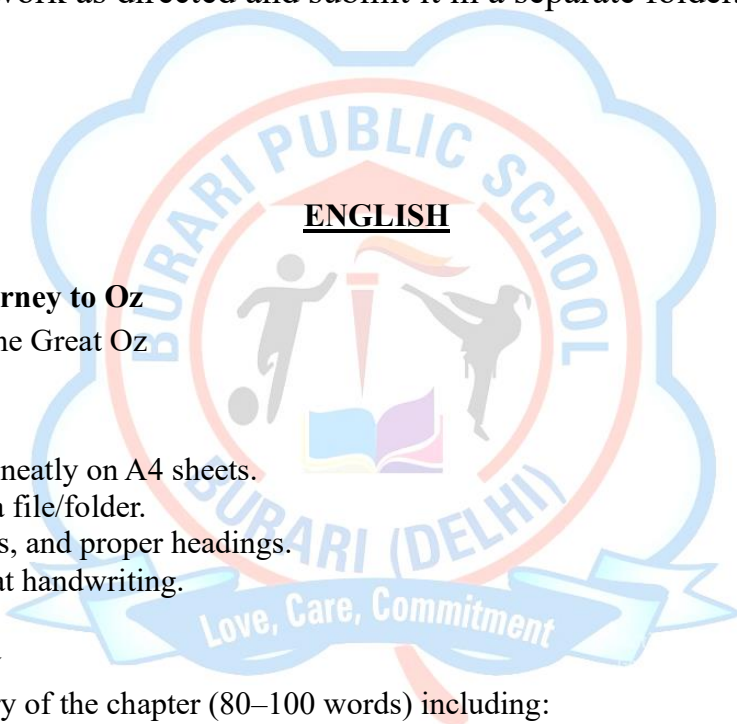

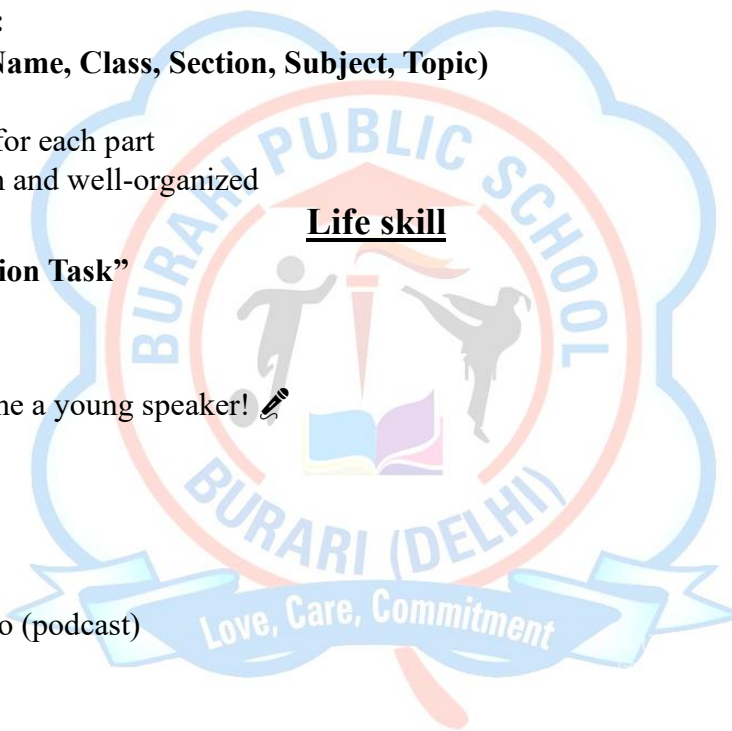
STEP-BY-STEP PROCESS

STEP 1: CHOOSE YOUR TOPIC

● **STEP 2: PREPARE YOUR SPEECH**

✍ Your speech should be 2–3 minutes long.

🗣 **WHAT SHOULD YOUR SPEECH INCLUDE?**

Follow this simple structure:

◆ **1. OPENING (Introduction)**

- * Greet the audience
- * Introduce your topic

🗣 **Example:**

“Good morning, everyone, today I am going to speak about...”

◆ **2. MAIN CONTENT (Body)**

- * Write 2–3 main points
- * Explain each point clearly
- * Give at least one example

◆ **3. CONCLUSION (Ending)**

- * Share your opinion
- * Give a message

🗣 **Example:**

“So, we should all try to...”

🗣 **EASY FORMULA TO REMEMBER**

🗣 Start → Explain → Example → End

● **STEP 3: PRACTICE**

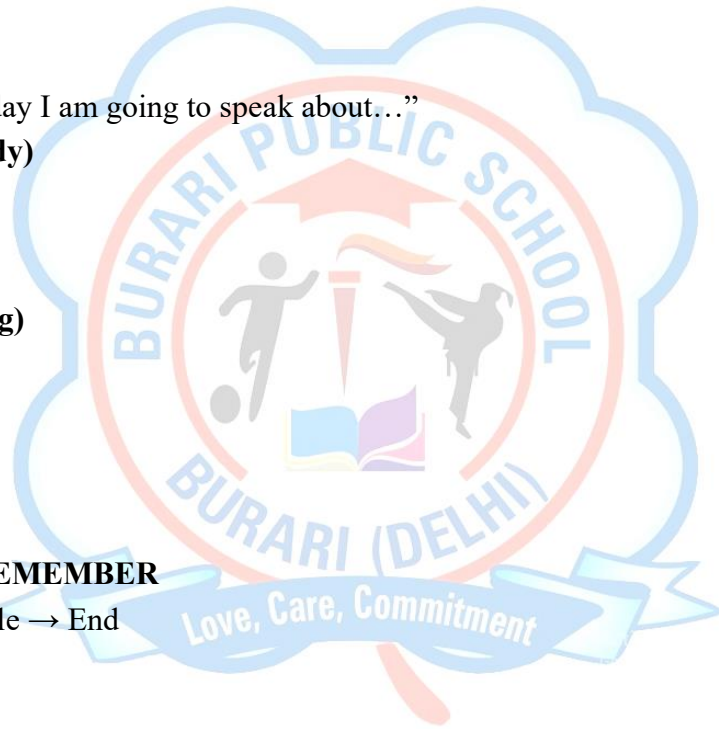
Before recording:

- ✓ Read your speech 2–3 times
- ✓ Practice speaking loudly and clearly
- ✓ Try to speak naturally (don't just read)

● **STEP 4: RECORD YOUR VIDEO / AUDIO 🎥**

🎥 **RECORDING TIPS**

- ✓ Speak clearly
- ✓ Look at the camera
- ✓ Use simple sentences
- ✓ Smile and be confident 😊
- ✓ Keep it natural (mistakes are okay!)

Final Output: Table + Meal Plan Chart



